7. Meeting Business

7 a i Lake Coleridge Rainbow Trout Spawning Survey

Both the drift dive count and the trout spawning activity showed decreases from previous years' results. However the last five surveys have shown a steady increase in both the numbers of trout and redds observed since 2010. "That NC F&G continues to undertake the spawning survey in the last week of September each year".

"That NC F&G continue with the survey each year to gain an understanding of trends in the Lake Coleridge fishery and monitor the success of rainbow releases into the spawning streams."

7 b ii Clearwater Golf Resort Angling Access

The following was tentatively agreed between the parties subject to Council approval regarding access to the Clearwater Lakes.

- Lake 5 open to the public on the eastern shoreline between markers (approx 100m)
- Lake 4 open along the western roadside (approx 300m)
- Lake 3 open to the public for a small area adjacent to Lake 4 access in the bay (approx 50m)
- Lakes 4A, 2 & 1 closed to all angling

<u>It was decided that the subject required further discussion and that R Cullinane seek advice from B</u> <u>Johnson on the matter.</u> The matter required to be a special case in the regulations.
