GAME REGULATIONS

The Council discussed a pre-circulated list of proposed changes by the chair. Agreeing to notify the following proposed regulations to West Coast Licence Holders;

- Increase Black Swan limit to 4 encourage harvest of a bird that is under-utilised.
- Retain Shelduck and Greylard limits as they are at 15 bag limit- to maximise hunting opportunities.
- Pukeko maintain current bag limit.
- Maintain current hunting season length.
- Amend the current March junior Paradise Shelduck hunting period to include Pukeko and lengthen to period to the first two weeks in March.
- Limit the ammunition capacity in guns used for game bird hunting to 5 shots.

Motion proposed: That the West Coast Fish and Game Council propose the above set of changes to the regulations with rationale, and notify these to West Coast Licence Holders with a one month submission period.

VOLUNTEER SERVICE RECOGNITION
