# LAKES ROTONGARO, LITTLE ROTONGARO AND OKOWHAO

### LAKES ROTONGARO AND LITTLE ROTONGARO (also known as Ratongaro-iti)

Wildlife Management Reserves—DoC Permit required. Some 340 hectares of open water connected by shallow canal and surrounded by farmland. Often popular area for geese. A DOC permit is required

# **Access Points**

### 1. Pukekapia Road

Vehicular and foot access to southern Lake Rotongaro from Pukekapia Road then along unformed public road to lake. Boat access probably summer only.

### 2. Rotongaro-Rangiriri Road

Vehicular and foot access across private lands. Landowner permission required. Provides access to northern Rotongaro lake.

## 3. Rotongaro-Rangiriri Road

Legal unformed public road provides difficult foot access to Little Rotongaro-iti.

## 4. Rotongaro-Rangiriri Road

Private land affords practical access only to Lake Little Rotongaro. Landowner permission required.

### LAKE OKOWHAO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT RESERVE

12 hectares of open water, surrounded by DOC reserve. DOC permit required.

### 5. Okowhao Road, Huntly

Legal public vehicle access via farm race to the western edge of reserve.

### 6. Te Ohaki Road, Huntly

Practical vehicular and foot access via private land. Landowner permission required.
