5. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE DECEMBER MINUTES/ACTION REQUIRED SCHEDULE

Members of The Whale Trail Cycle Trust will give a second presentation at 1pm following the onsite visit that took place in December with Fish & Game Councillors and Staff.

The Manager reported that in winter when the summer field work programme is completed, he will continue his liaison with Iwi on the draft Sports Fish and Game Bird Management Plan.

The Manager will contact Andrew Pearson (MPI) and request a copy of the interim 1080 research report, as to date we have only received a brief email.

6. FISH & GAME RESOURCE ALLOCATION PROJECT.BY Concept Consulting There was a mixed reaction to this paper points made included.

- May have been better to complete this task after the up-and-coming National Anglers Survey
- The National Anglers Survey needs to be more intensive (more detailed questions asked) and maybe more frequently to get better angler information.
- Included all income not just licence income which made those regions that had other income look over resourced.
- West Coast looks under resource because NM do their admin (NM look over resourced because they get income for doing this work.
- The graph showing what Fish & Game NZ spend money on should have been a graph showing where Fish & Game NZ staff hours are spent.
- This is only a financial allocation project and does not consider regional habitat resources which is what was thought this project was also going to address.
- what is missing is an indication of how each region's budget would change if the DEO allocation process was implemented.

Councillors were asked to have another read of the paper and if they come up with more comments to forward these to the manager via email before the 26th of February when NZ Council need feedback. The manager will respond to NZ Council.

7. DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION LIAISON

Chris Golding updated the Council on

• Predator control programme.

- The 3 million dollars grant the Tasman District Council has received for wetland restoration/recovery projects that is part of the governments creating jobs for nature.
- New Regional Fresh Water Advisory Role that hopefully will be filled soon.

Chris was asked what was the Department's policy on Water Conservation Orders. – Chris will report back on this.

The topic of getting better information from helicopter concession returns to assist Fish and Game to better manage back country fisheries was brought up again, this was discussed back in 2019 when the Manager and FO Lucas produced in conjunction with Racquel Edmonds DOC Senior National Transaction Centre Advisor a list of questions which Fish & Game would like answered. This was provided but gave us very little information, and concession information is not all due at the same time.

If/when a Guides licence is introduced this information will be easier to obtain.

8. THE WHALE TRAIL.

Nigel Muir (Trustee) and Vicki Nalder (Construction Manager) presented to the Council the second draft proposal for the route of the cycle trail from Picton to Blenheim. This was completed after Trust members, F&G staff and Councillors walked the proposed route in December. Mitigation ideas for Fish & Game to consider were.

- Begin screen planting now in key areas.
- An option could be to restrict shells to 2 ¾ inch.
- Build permanent maimai's in key areas of conflict with the idea of positioning the maimai's away from the western side of Para, these structures could have multiple uses, e.g., bird watching out of season.

A sub committee was formed to work with The Whale Trail Trust to come up with a concept plan for the area of the trail that borders the Para Wetland.

Councillor Gauld asked that his objection to this whole proposal be recorded.
