

Fish & Game access key annual changeover

Environment Canterbury's Fish & Game access keys allow entrance via selected gates along the Waimakariri River. The gate locks are changed over annually.

The changeover takes place around October 1 each year. To ensure uninterrupted access, key holders need to exchange their existing key for a new one. There are two ways you can swap, or return, your key.

1. In person: Come see us at either our Christchurch or Amberley office, bringing your current key and new annual fishing licence with you. This is the fastest way to update your key.

66 Carters Road, SH1, Amberley, open Mon-Fri from 8am-4pm.

2. By post: Post us your current key, along with a clear copy of your new annual fishing licence and a completed swap/return form (see below). We will then post the new key back to you. Please allow plenty of time for this option. Note: please check with your local post office about the best method of mailing the key – standard paper envelopes are not recommended due to it getting stuck in the machine, lost, or stolen.
