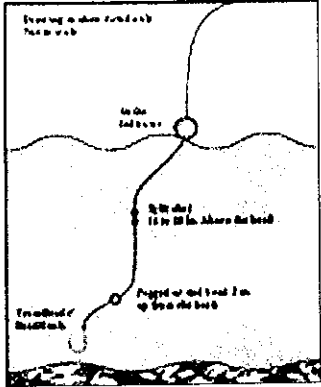


Jimmys Handy Hints for Catching pond Trout and Salmon



1. Trout / Salmon don't feed all day !! So for good results start as early as possible, the first three hours and last three hours of the day are the most active feeding times.
2. Trout / Salmon spook easily !! Try and be as quiet as possible (kids throwing rocks in the pond will not help!)

3. Fishing Gear Trout / Salmon have good eye site !! For best results use light main line and light trace 6-8lb.

Rig 1. Use 1-2 metre trace ,6-8lb with small bare hook. Attach bobble float (see diagram) add a small split shot sinker to help with casting . Check your Jimmys bait pellet every 5—10 Minutes.

Rig 2. Same as rig 1 but remove the bobble float and let the line sink to the bottom. Check your Jimmys bait pellet every 5—10 minutes.

Rig 3. For the more experienced fisherman use a lightly weighted Nymph (Hares Ear or similar) size 12—14. Attach to metre long trace 6-8lb, use small split shot sinker to aid with casting . Keep the nymph on the move ,regular casting and sinking technique. Pinch a little Jimmys Bait Pellet and place it on your nymph hook .
